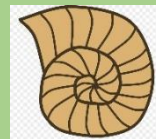

Go to the beach on a **fossil hunting** adventure with an adult.



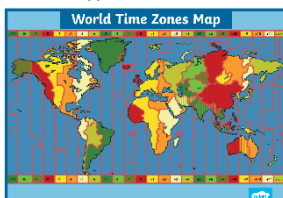
Although fossils can be quite tricky to find, you might be able to find one if you are **patient and look very carefully!**
